

Having challenged the Corinthians to reach their world and to understand how the world thinks, Paul reminds them that all is to be done to God’s glory.

- I. **God’s Plan (His Servants)** vv.26-28
 - A. Our calling (“Not many” v.26)
 - B. God’s choice (vv.27-28)

- II. **God’s Purpose (His Glory)** vv.29-30
 - A. There is nothing to glory of in ourselves (v.29; Eph. 2:8-9)
 - B. All we need is in Christ (v.30; Phil. 1:21)

- III. **God’s Praise (The Glory is the Lord’s)** v.31
 - A. He deserves our glory (v.30; II Cor. 10:7)
 - B. God delights in our glory (“As it is written” Jer. 9:23-24)
